JAGANNATH GUPTA MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL is situated at K.P Mondal road, Buita, Budge Budge, Kolkata about a distance of 20 kms away from the heart of the capital city of Kolkata. It is well connected with the city by railways & road transport. The newly constructed Sampri flyover makes the journey pleasurable. The nearest airport is situated at a distance of less than 45 kms from the college.

The 1st batch of 150 MBBS students were admitted in 2018 after obtaining permission from the Ministry of health & family welfare, Govt of India, on recommendation of Medical Council of India. It is a 380 bedded teaching hospital with 24x7 emergency services, fully equipped ICU, ICCU, NICU/PICU, SICU with trained ICU staffs. All OPD consultations are free of cost for the benefits of the socio-economically challenged people in and around South 24 parganas. The infrastructure is spread on a sprawling 24 acres campus, with the educational hub consisting of Jagannath Gupta Institute of Medical Sciences & Hospital, Jagannath Gupta Nursing College & Paramedical College with a projected 1000-bedded hospital, 100 ICU beds, projected 11 major OT's. Our medical college aims to train students to become doctors with requisite medical knowledge & good clinical skills to serve the medical needs of the society. We welcome our students to come & experience our world class teaching facilities with state of art infrastructure & highly trained & qualified faculties & other supporting staffs.

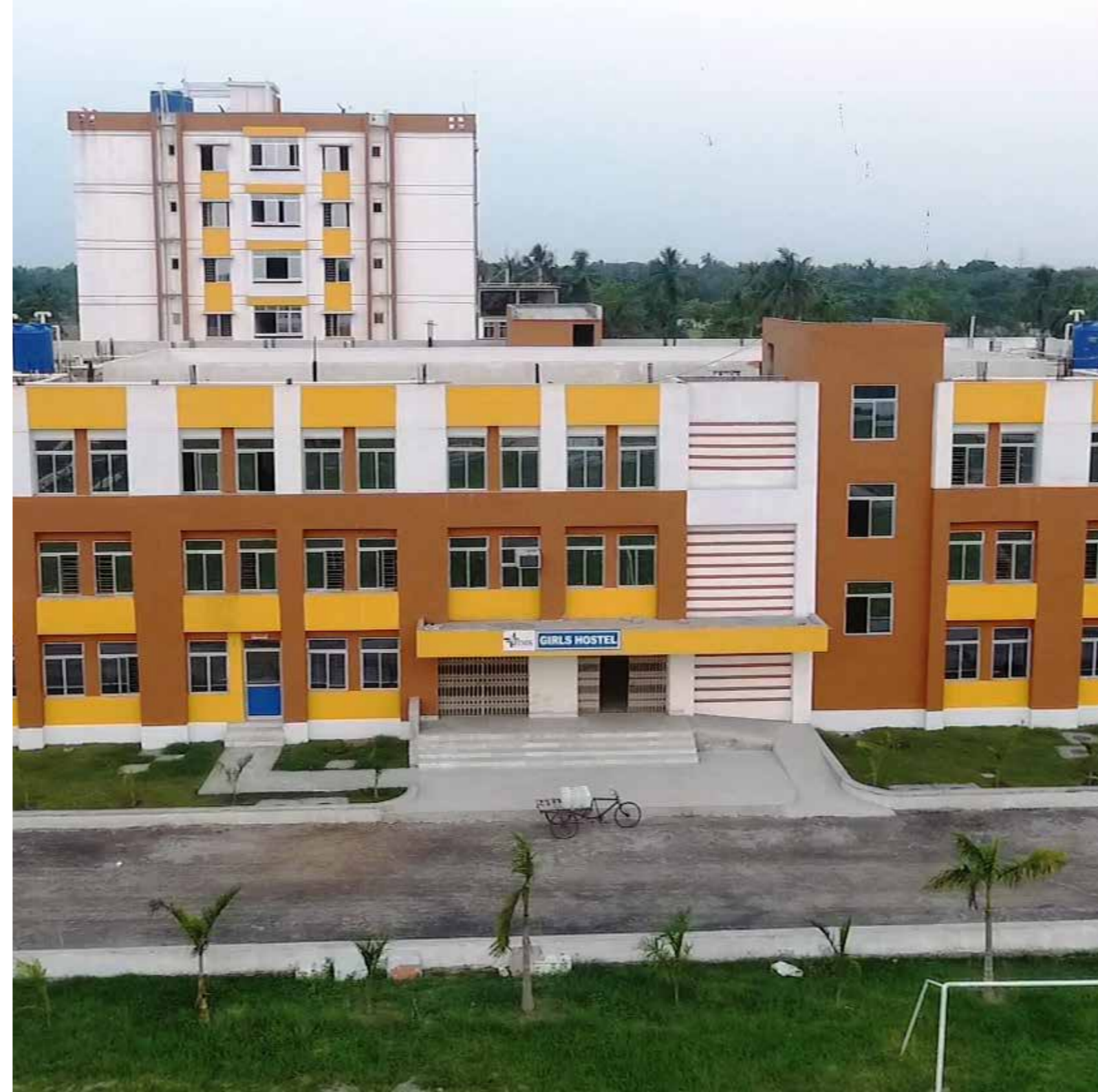

About the Medical College

THE departments in the medical college has been built & equipped to teach the foundation course of the MBBS curriculum with the best in class equipment with experienced & qualified faculty members. All departments have spacious, well equipped laboratories to accommodate 150 students as stipulated by MCI. All departments are having a separate research laboratories where faculties perform various basic & clinical research activities. Each departments are also equipped with laboratories with attached preparation room, demonstration room with sitting capacity of 75 students, departmental library with seminar room. The anatomy department has its dissection hall located at the ground floor along with cold storage room & embalming room. Operation Theatre

Our operating theatres are state-of-the-art facilities designed for optimal efficiency, and facilitate a seamless operational flow for performing complex surgical operations. Every one of our operating rooms is equipped with sophisticated equipment from positive pressure rooms and ceiling-mounted equipment units to the latest advancements in surgical technology for performance at the highest level. To reduce the risk of infection, all units operate with single-use surgical devices only.

We here at JIMSH have 5 Major OTs and 3 Minor OTs.



ICU

The Intensive Care Unit (ICU) houses state-of-the-art medical equipments & infrastructure required to assist the medical staffs in caring of critically ill patients. The ICU staff includes doctors, nurses, respiratory therapists, clinical nurse specialists, pharmacists, physical therapists & dieticians.

ICCU

To give a new lease of life to critically ill cardiac patients we have an intensive coronary care unit with advanced monitoring and life support systems under the supervision of a capable cardiologist with attending resident doctors.

SICU

The Surgical Intensive Care Unit provides care for patients who have undergone a myriad of critical surgical procedures. It is a medical care centre for critically ill patients who require surgery or are recovering from surgery. The professionals in the SICU are your health care advocates. We understand the stresses placed on you and your family in critical care situations. We communicate with you, your family and other members of your medical team to provide the best possible care.

NICU/PICU

Both the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) & Paediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU) specialises in the monitoring and care of ill or premature new-born infants. The NICU/PICU also admits babies with congenital problems or trauma during delivery and combines sophisticated equipment with trained healthcare professionals to provide specialised care for new-born infants.

Central Laboratory

There is one well-equipped Central Research Laboratory. There are 6 other laboratories (225 sq.m. area each) which are provided with continuous working tables. One preparation room each of 15 sq.m. area is provided with all the laboratories. There are 2 laboratories of 90 Sq.m. area each. All of these laboratories are used in common with various departments e.g. Histology and Histopathology; Biochemistry and Clinical Pharmacology; Haematology and Pathology; Microbiology and Community Medicine.

Radio Diagnosis Services

The state-of-the-art imaging equipment includes open high-field CT scanner 16 Slice, X- Ray, USG, colored Doppler. Using these devices, our trained radiologists provide high-level service to the patients who are in need of radiology services. Based on the reports, the concerned physicians recommend the treatment to be given to the patients. We take every care to ensure patient comfort, safety, and well-being before, during and after the medical procedures.

COURSES OFFERED

1. MBBS- Medical Council of India permission for admission of 150 students. It is affiliated to WBUHS.

University Rules & Regulations

I. Course duration- 4^{1/2} Years+1 Year Internship. Each year consist of two semesters, each of six months duration.

II. Examination schedule- as per university schedule. One regular & one supplementary professional MBBS examination. The supplementary examination will be held ordinarily not earlier than six weeks, but not later than six months, after the publication of the results of the regular examination.

III. Eligibility criteria for appearing in MBBS examination

The student should have compulsorily attended a regular course of study for the prescribed period in the college. A minimum of 75% attendance in all subjects is compulsory(including attendance in non-lecture classes like demonstration, practical, tutorial, seminar, group discussion etc.). The attendance will be certified by the Principal/ Dean of the institution. There is no provision of condonation of shortage of attendance(due to any cause whatsoever) or of appearance as non-collegiate candidate under any circumstances, whatsoever.

IV. Internal assessment- It should be based on continuous evaluation (may be daily/weekly/ fortnightly/monthly/ bimonthly) of the students or otherwise, as well as periodical examinations. Nature of continuous assessment may be through item cards/ oral/ practical/ short questions/ multiple choice question test shall be objectively assessed & recorded. There shall be two periodical internal assessment examinations.



2. BSC NURSING-

Course duration-4 years
It is affiliated to WBUHS & and recognised by West Bengal Nursing Council. A minimum of 75% attendance in all subjects is compulsory (including attendance in non-lecture classes like demonstration, practical, tutorial, seminar, group discussion etc.) for appearing in examination. Examinations will be conducted every year as per the university schedule.

3. GNM-

Course duration-3 years
It is affiliated to WBUHS & and recognised by West Bengal Nursing Council. A minimum of 75% attendance in all subjects is compulsory (including attendance in non-lecture classes like demonstration, practical, tutorial, seminar, group discussion etc.) for appearing in examination. Examinations will be conducted every year as per the university schedule.

4. PARAMEDICAL-

Course duration-2 years
It is under the state medical faculty of west Bengal. The courses being offered are approved courses of the state government & the diplomas/ certificate awarded by the faculty are recognised by various states as well as central authorities for the purpose of employment.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

MBBS- 150 seats

Candidates who are citizens of India, NRIs, PIOs, OCIs and foreign nationals are eligible to take NEET.

ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE

Objectives

Ragging of any kind is declared as a criminal offense and is strictly banned in the Hospital, its hostels as per the Honorable Supreme Court directions. The goal of the committee is to comply as per directives of the court. Ragging is perceived as lack of human values.

Activities

The committee to look into the nuisance of ragging; studying various aspects of ragging, means and methods to prevent it, possible action that can be taken against those who indulge in it, and action against offenders in the event of ragging.

Duties and responsibilities

To publicize and ensure all concerned read the Supreme Court recommendations; the recommendations imply the role and responsibility of anti – ragging committee

- The punishment to be meted out has to be exemplary



and justifiably harsh to act as a deterrent against recurrence of such incidents.

- Every single incident of ragging where the victim or guardians or the Head of institution is not satisfied with the institutional arrangement for action, a First Information Report must be filed without exception by the institutional authorities with the local police authorities. Any failure on the part of the institutional authority or negligence or deliberate delay in lodging the FIR with the local police shall be construed to be an act of culpable negligence on the part of the institutional authority. If any victim or other of ragging intends to file FIR directly with the police, that will not absolve the institutional authority from the requirement of filing the FIR.

- In case the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that he has indulged in ragging, admission may be refused or he shall be expelled from the educational institution.

- It shall be the collective responsibility of the authorities and functionaries of the concerned institution and their role shall also be open to scrutiny for the purpose of finding out whether they have taken effective steps for preventing ragging and in case of their failure, action can be taken; for example, denial of any grant-in-aid or assistance from the State Governments.

- Anti-ragging committees and squads is formed by the institution and it shall be the job of the committee or the squad, as the case may be, to see that the Committees recommendations, more particularly those noted above, are observed without exception and if it is noticed that there is any deviation, the same shall be forthwith brought to the notice of this Court.

- The Committee constituted pursuant to the order of this Court shall continue to monitor the functioning of the anti-ragging committees and the squads to be formed. They shall also monitor the implementation of the recommendations to which reference has been made above.

- Signed documentary will be taken from students in tune with the provisions of anti-ragging verdict by the Honorable Supreme Court.

- We also have mentor committee to monitor the wellbeing of the students.

GENDER AND SEXUAL HARASSMENT CELL

Objectives

To prevent sexual harassment and to promote the general well-being of female students/employees of the Institute.

- To provide the healthy and safe environment in the Institute for the female students / employees.
- To provide guidelines for the redressal of grievances related to sexual harassment of female students/employees of the institution.

Responsibilities

To sustain the dignity of women.

- To facilitate congenial working environment so that any female employee is not subjected to gender specific discrimination.
- To consider the complaints of grievances from female teaching staff, non-teaching staff and students and investigate them thoroughly within stipulated time.
- To ensure confidentiality and time bound response to the complaints.
- To heighten awareness and sensitivity to this important issue amongst all the female staff and students. For this purpose motivational and developmental activities shall be organized.

- The reading room is kept open for 24 hours on all days (except holidays).

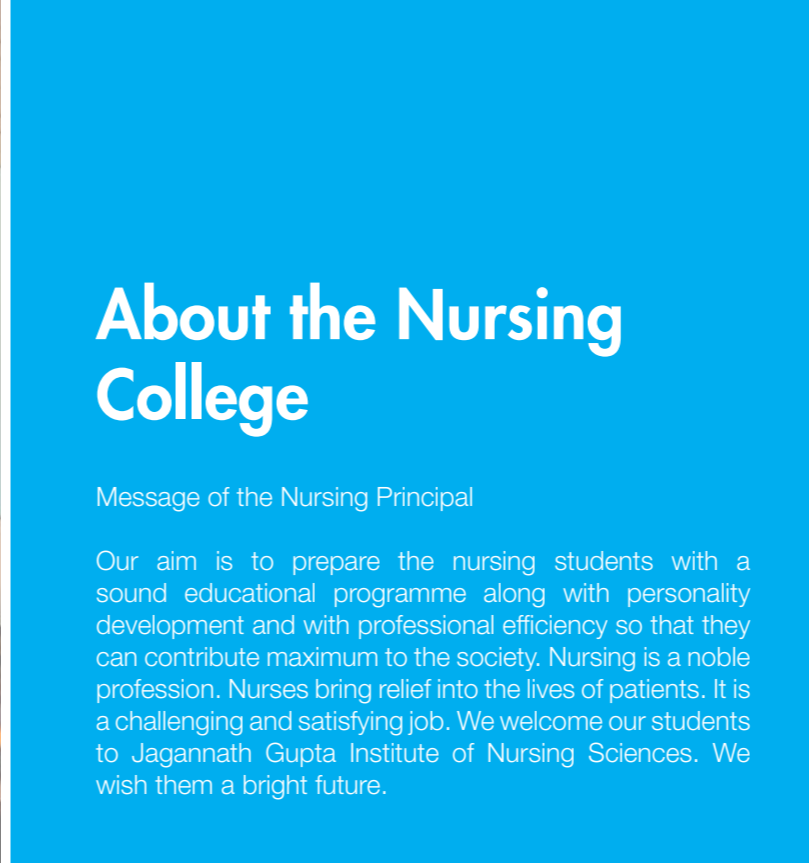
Computer & internet

B.SC. NURSING

All admission through JENPAUH counselling

- The candidate must pass H.S (10+2) examination of the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent from any recognized Board/Council in regular class mode.
- The candidate must pass in science stream with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English as compulsory subjects with individual pass marks (in both theory and practical separately, wherever applicable) in each of the subjects.
- The candidate must also secure minimum 45% (40% for SC/ST/OBC-A & B, PwD candidates) marks in aggregate in 10+2 level.
- The candidate must be medically fit to undergo the course.
- All Applicants must be above the age of 17 years at the time of admission.
- No maximum age limit decided for the applicants by the authorities.

GNM

The eligibility criteria for the admission on GNM Nursing training course, depends upon two factors, one is Educational Qualification and the other is Age limit.

1. **Educational Qualification:** Candidates must have to pass Higher Secondary Examination (10th+2) from West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or from any recognized Council/Board for applying in GNM course.
2. **Age Limit:** The minimum age limit of the applicant must be 17 years and maximum 27years. **Selection will be made strictly on the basis of the total marks obtained in the compulsory subjects (one language subject + English and other best of three subjects except Envs.) in the Higher Secondary (10+2) or equivalent examination.** Vocational stream students are not eligible.
